## Classics on the Common – Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2019

We invite you to join us for our 26<sup>th</sup> Anniversary event and encourage you to book soon to secure your place. There will be three groups of vehicles. Please note that we have reduced the age limit but kept the same entry donations.

**Group A** 2pm entry for Vehicles which are 25 years or older: registered in 1994 or before

**Group B** 11.30am entry for Vehicles which are 25 years or older

**Group C** 11.30am entry for Vehicles that may have been admitted before but not 25 years old

The minimum entry donation will again be £12 for Group A and £17 for Group B and Group C.

**Motorcycles and Scooters** There will be no age qualification for motorcycles and scooters but you will need to book in advance. **Please note: no tickets will be available on the day of the event and anyone arriving without a ticket will not be admitted.** Entry will be allowed from 11.30 am via the main entrance opposite the Silver Cup public house. **The minimum donation will be £8.**

**Ticket Applications** If your vehicle or motorcycle qualifies for entry, please complete the ticket application form and forward it with a Stamped Addressed Envelope (so that we can send you the ticket) and a cheque for your donation made payable to 'Classics on the Common'. Additional application forms are available on our website; [www.classicsonthecommon.com](http://www.classicsonthecommon.com). **To ensure we recover our unavoidable costs, in the unlikely event of Classics being cancelled, your ticket donation is non-refundable.**

**Substitute Vehicles** Your ticket will display your vehicle's registration number. If you need to come in a substitute qualifying vehicle, you must provide full details, including registration number, **in advance**, by emailing [info@classicsonthecommon.com](mailto:info@classicsonthecommon.com) or by writing to Classics on the Common, 67 High Street, Harpenden AL5 2SL or, from 22 July, by ringing 07986 067842. Do **not** alter the registration number on your ticket. If the substitute vehicle does not meet the minimum age requirement a spectator car park must be used.

**Start Time** Start time will again be 2pm **unless you have an early entry ticket** in which case you will be allowed on the Common from 11.30am. We also request that you stay on the Common until at least 5.30 pm. This is to minimize congestion as vehicles arrive through the afternoon. Motorcycles and scooters will be allowed on the Common from 11.30am.

**We have been asked to remind you that barbecues are not permitted on the Common and as we are very limited for space, no gazebos are allowed.**

**Charities** Last year, thanks to the generosity of owners, spectators, our advertisers and sponsors we raised over £37,500 for charity. A helpful slice of that came back from the Tax man through from Gift Aid and we encourage you to tick the box on the application form for any donations over the minima. Our main charities for 2019 will be: Luton, South Beds and Harpenden Samaritans, Alzheimer's Society, Carers in Hertfordshire and Rotary Doctor Bank.
