We invite you to join us for our 27th Anniversary event. **The minimum fee of £12 has been held for the fourth year. All entry fees are listed on the application form.**

Motorcycles and Scooters There will be no age qualification for motorcycles and scooters but you will need to book in advance. The minimum fee will be £8.

Please note: no tickets will be available on the day of the event and anyone arriving without a ticket will not be admitted. However, if there are spaces available on the day, motorcycles and scooters will be admitted for a donation of £10.

Ticket Applications If your vehicle or motorcycle qualifies for entry, please complete the ticket application form and forward it with a Stamped Addressed Envelope (so that we can send you the ticket) and a cheque for your donation made payable to 'Classics on the Common'. Additional application forms are available on our website; www.classicsonthecommon.com. **To ensure we recover our unavoidable costs, in the event of our having to cancel Classics, your ticket donation is non-refundable.**

Substitute Vehicles Your ticket will display your vehicle's registration number. If you need to come in a substitute qualifying vehicle, you must provide full details, including registration number, **in advance**, by emailing info@classicsonthecommon.com or by writing to Classics on the Common, 67 High Street, Harpenden AL5 2SL or, from 20 September, by ringing 07986 067842. Do **not** alter the registration number on your ticket. If the substitute vehicle does not meet the minimum age requirement a spectator car park must be used.

Earlier start Time Start time will be 1.00pm **unless you have an early entry ticket** in which case you will be allowed on the Common from 11.00am. We also request that you stay on the Common until at least 4.30 pm. This is to minimize congestion as vehicles arrive throughout the afternoon. Motorcycles and scooters will be allowed on the Common from 11.00am.

Harpenden Town Council has asked us to remind you that barbecues are not permitted on the Common and as we are very limited for space, no gazebos are allowed.

Charities Thanks to the generosity of owners, spectators, our advertisers and sponsors, our last event raised over £33,500 for charity. A helpful slice of that came from Gift Aid and we encourage you to tick the box on the application form for any donations over the minima. Our main charities for 2021 will be posted on our website in due course.
